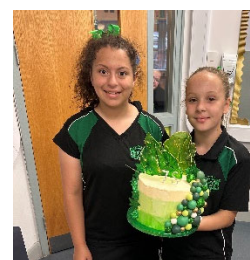
Interform

Again, the weather wasn't on our side for sports day and had to be postponed until the following day.

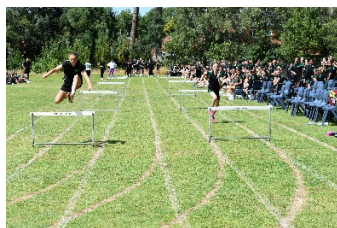
It was great to see everyone support each other and have a great day! It was brilliant to see the companionship shown towards each other and the athletic ability was fantastic. Results are as follows:
